What is Google Classroom?

- A shared space where teachers can upload assignments, homework, school news, and more with students and parents!



Getting Started!

- Your child was provided with a secure login and password that is unique to them.
- They will have to sign in with that to access Google Classroom.
- If you do not have this information, it may be in your child's agenda. If you can not find it, please **email** their classroom teacher.



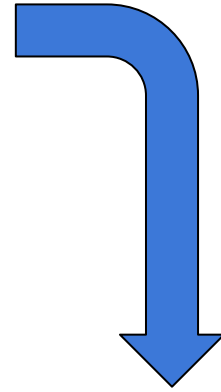
Step 1...

- Click on the Google Chrome browser icon.



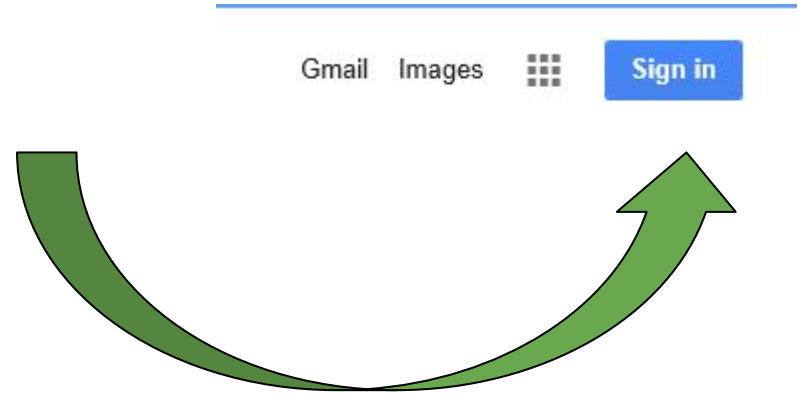
Step 2...

address bar.



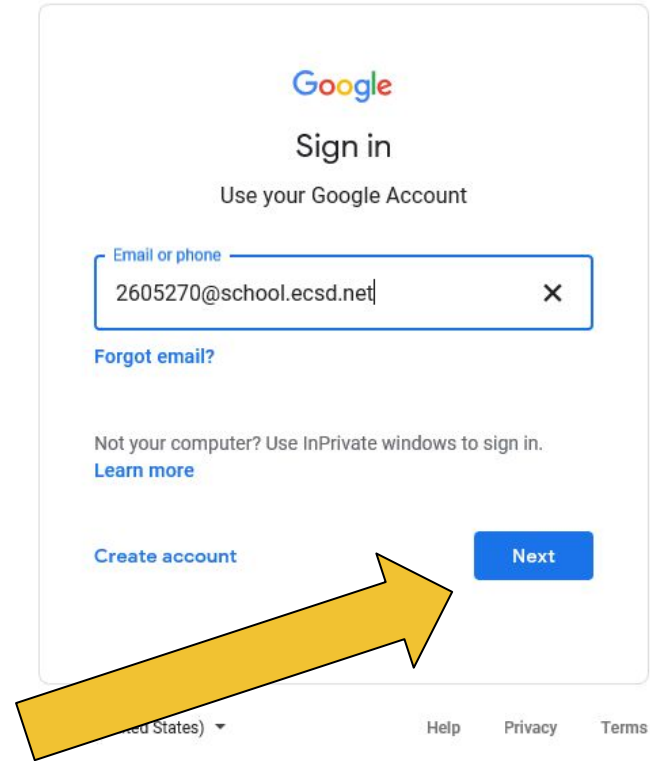
Step 3...

Step 4...

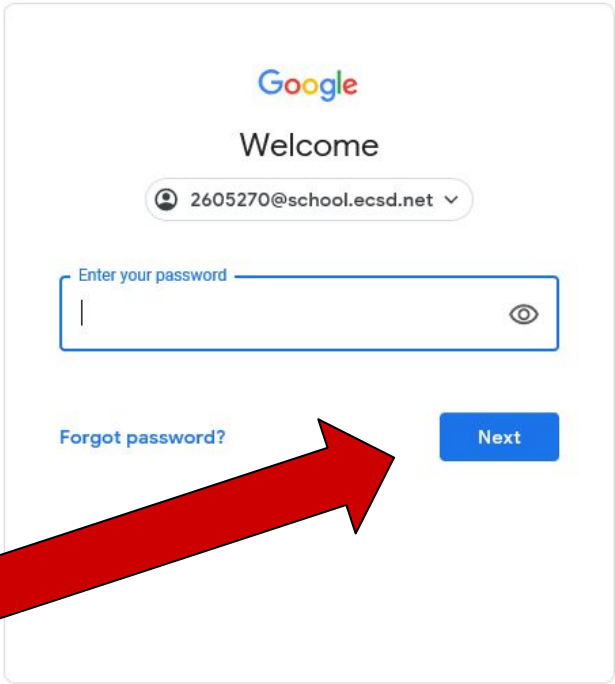
- Type in your child's Google email address & click "next."
- Their email address will be their computer login number followed by "@school.ecsd.net"

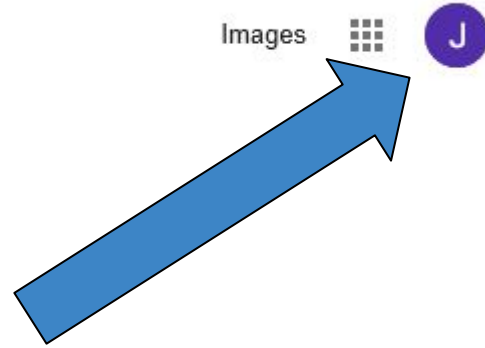

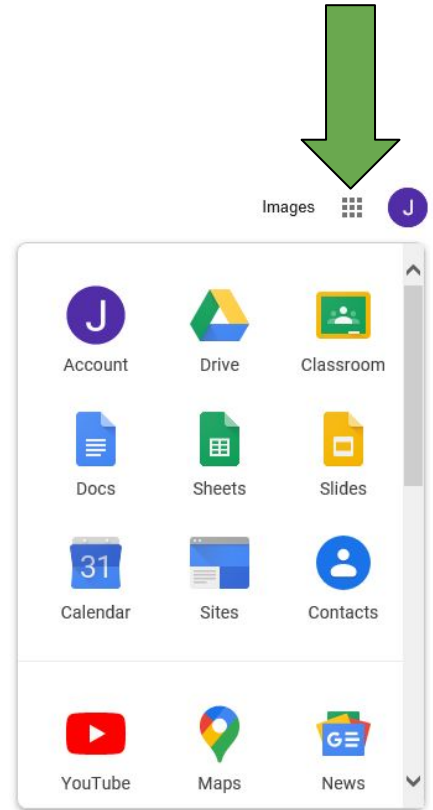
Step 6...

- Now you will see that you are signed in. It will have the first initial of your first name.



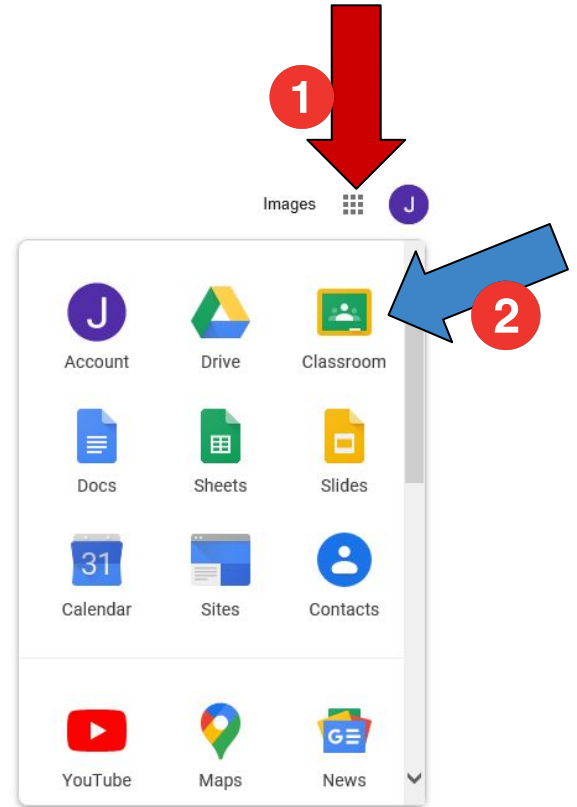
Step 7...

- Click on the 9 squares (Waffle/Rubik's Cube) icon in the top right hand corner to see the Google Suite of Products!



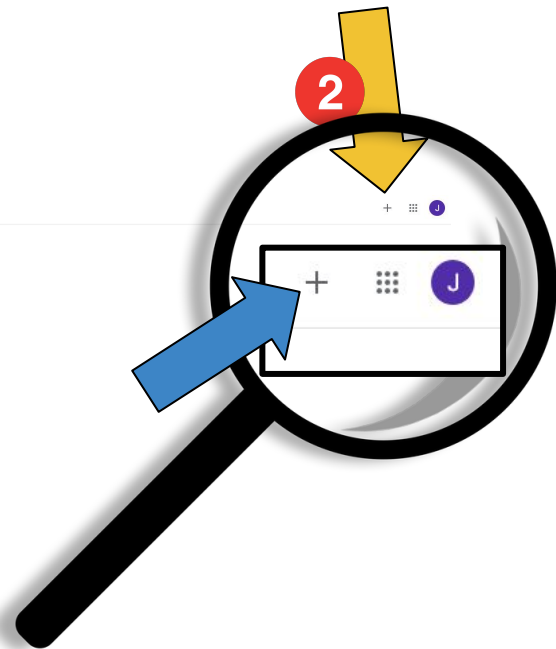
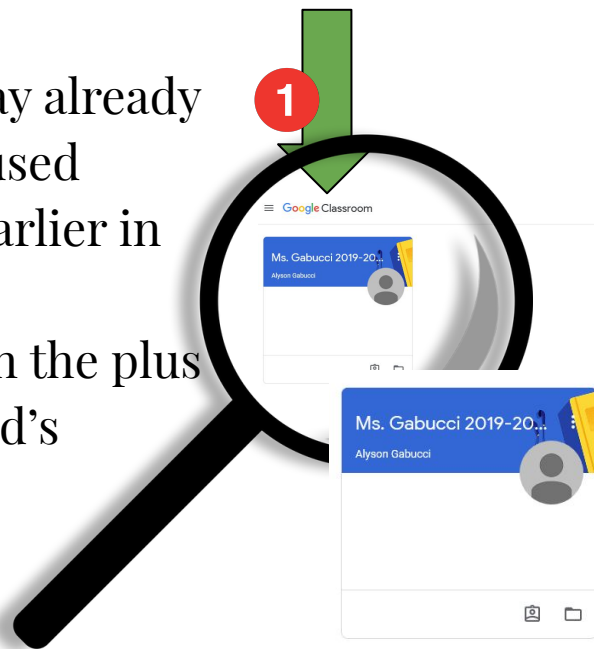
Step 8...

- Click on the waffle button and then the Google Classroom icon.



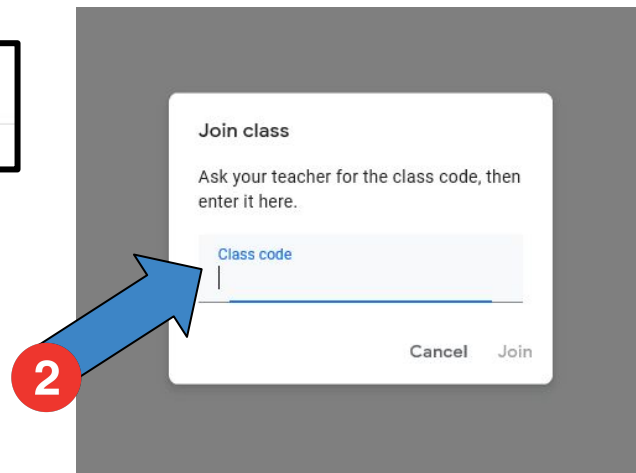
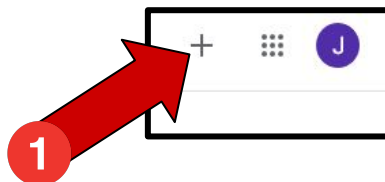
Step 9...

- If not, please click on the plus sign to add your child's classroom (2).



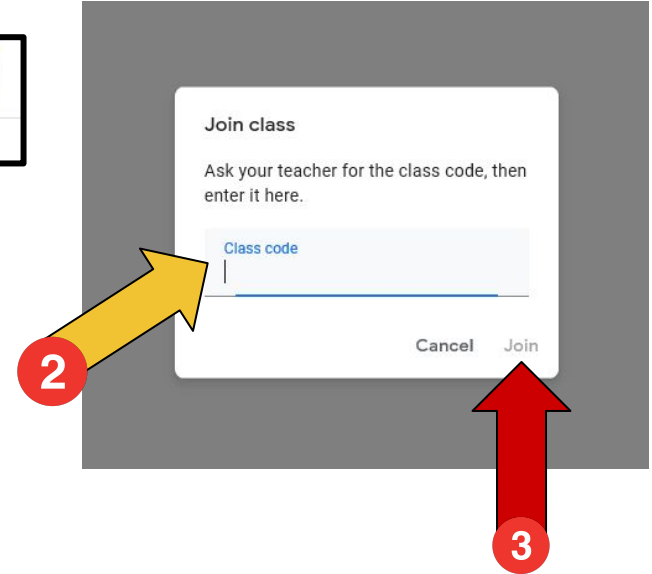
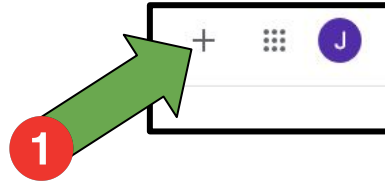
Step 10...

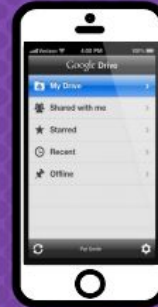
